## Form for Notification of Advanced Placement Credits

Advanced Placement (AP) credit may be awarded for academic skills acquired outside of formal university-level coursework, e.g., through secondary education. AP credit is conditional on a demonstrated level of competence equivalent to a university-level course regularly offered at Constructor University. Not all Constructor University modules or module components are eligible for AP; students should contact the relevant Instructor of Record and the Study Program Chair of the major in which the module is offered to ascertain whether AP credit may be earned for a particular module or component. **AP forms** can be submitted throughout the study period but **are ideally handed in at the start of the 1<sup>st</sup> semester; a submission must take place within the drop/add period**, given that the recognition has to be refused if an examination procedure is already in progress (i.e. registration for the module has taken place) or a grade has already been achieved.

Faculty may request students applying for AP to pass a formal written examination lasting no more than ninety minutes, which should be offered during the first two weeks of classes. Alternatively, Faculty may consider internationally recognized standardized test results (for instance, British A Levels, the French baccalauréat, the German Abitur, College Board AP Exams, Higher Level International Baccalaureate Exams, etc.) as being equivalent to a Constructor-administered formal examination. **Any such waiver of a written examination must be supported by both the Instructor of Record and the respective Study Program Chair.**

AP credits thus recognized by Constructor University will be designated on the transcript as being Advanced Placement courses (AP). No grade will be shown, nor will any grade be included in the student's grade point average.
