Information for students requiring a visa to enter Germany: Students who need a visa must provide a blocked account with € 11,400 at the German Embassy as proof of sufficient funding for their visa application. This blocked account is intended for living expenses, including rent, food, personal care & miscellaneous expenses as well as health insurance and residence permit for 12 months. Student should bear in mind that no financing options are available for their living expenses and that they are solely responsible for any additional costs which may occur during their enrollment.

** The total cost of tuition for one academic year at Constructor University excluding scholarships is € 20,000 for the following graduate programs: Advanced Software Technology, Data Engineering, Supply Chain Management, Data Science for Society & Business, Computer Science and Software Engineering.

› Tuition

For one academic year.

› University fee

Covers the student government fee, the graduation fees, etc.

› Semester ticket

Allows students to travel on local public transportation at no additional cost for the entire year (including local trains to neighboring cities like Hannover, Hamburg, Osnabrück, and Oldenburg).

› Enrollment deposit

In order to confirm your acceptance of our offer of admission, you must pay a one-time enrollment deposit of € 500. The enrollment deposit is a down payment on your first semester's fees. Please remember to deduct the € 500 from your first invoice yourself.

› Accommodation

For our master students Constructor University offers attractive accommodation off campus in the city of Bremen (room only). Prospective graduate students may apply for

accommodation when applying for the program of their choice.

› Residence permit

Required of all non-German students studying in Germany.

› Health insurance

Required of all students under the age of 30! If you are over 30 years of age, you must arrange for a health insurance that covers the entire period of your enrollment. The insurance must conform to the visa regulation of the German Embassy.
