Wolf is a global collegiate university.

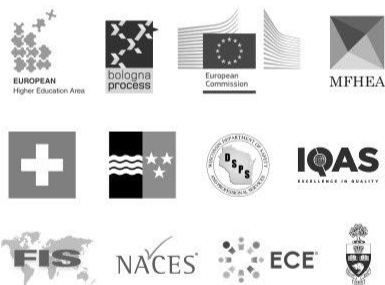
Our mission is to increase access to world-class higher education and ensure that it is globally recognized and transferable.

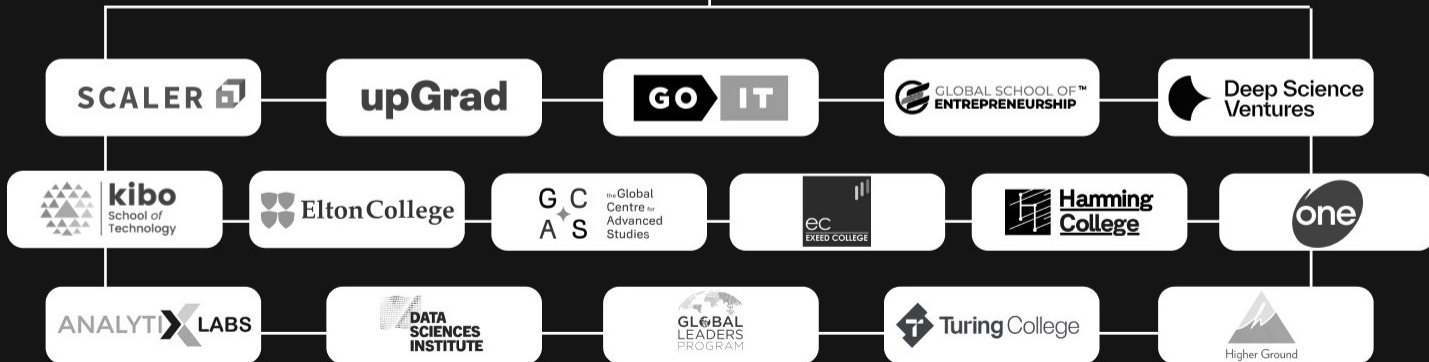

Accreditation Management System (AMS)

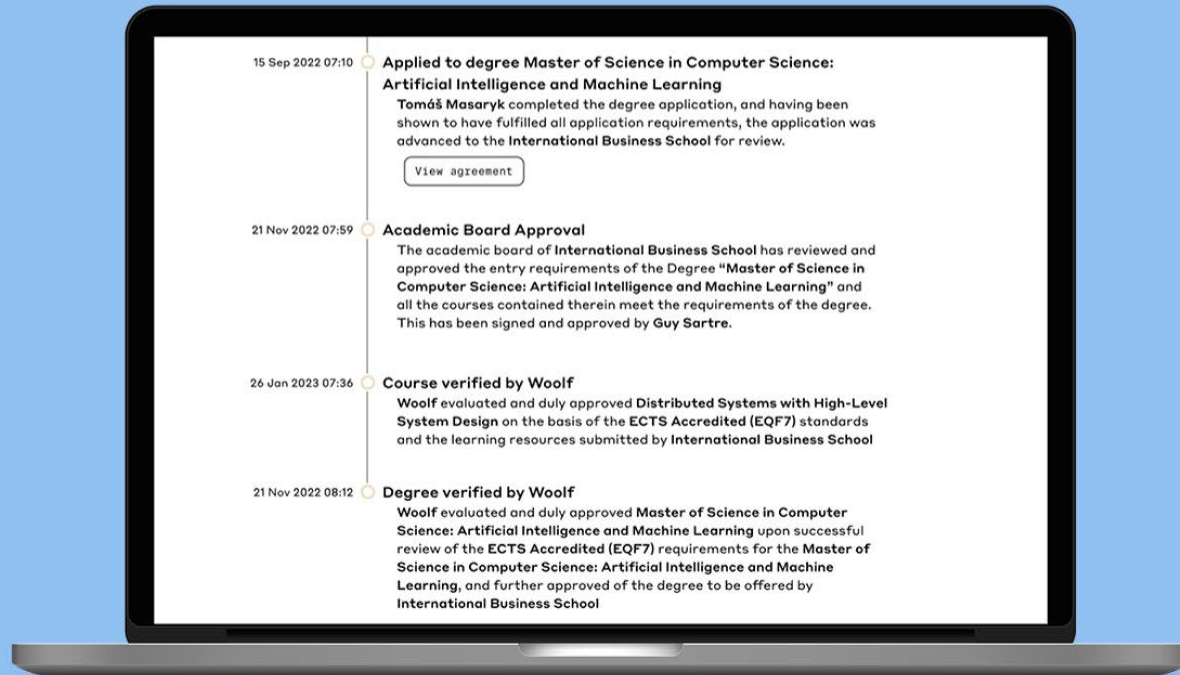


Woolf built an innovative digital operating system for quality assurance.

Ensures that Woolf member colleges' staff, and curriculum meet and maintain regulatory requirements.

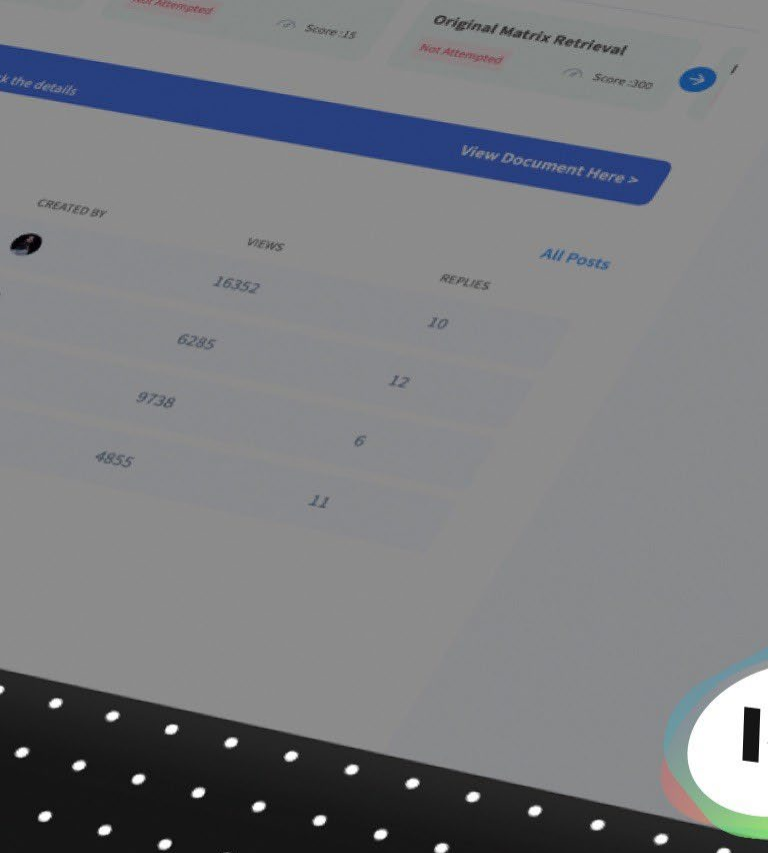
Records all the information needed for regulatory audits in the accreditation activity history.

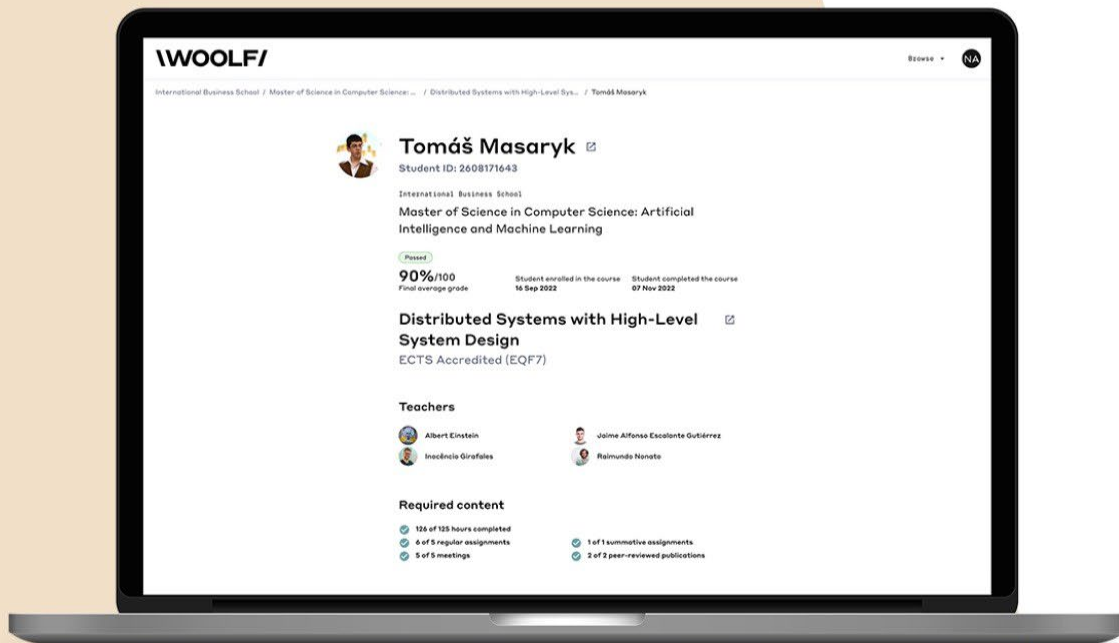

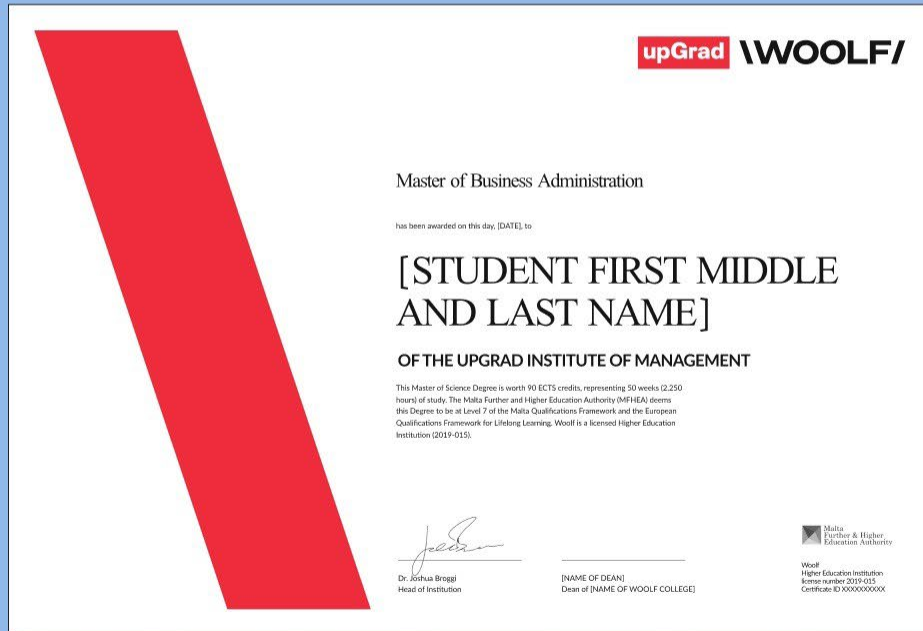
