Self-Service Requests

Once you're a student at Constructor University you will receive your credentials for the platform CampusNet. Via your CampusNet Dashboard you can request the following documents:

- Enrollment Confirmation Letter
- English Support Letter
- Transcript reflecting your current study results

The documents generated via the self-service are valid without a stamp or signature and can only be downloaded for the current semester.

If you require a stamped and signed version of the document, please refer to our <u>pre-existing</u> <u>request system</u>.

Self-Service Requests

How to make requests via the Student Self-Service (screenshots to be found on the following slides)

- 1. Use your computer/phone to go to the following website: campusnet.constructor.univeristy
- 2. Log into your account using your Constructor University credentials
- 3. Click on "Dashboard" on the top menu
- 4. Click on "Student Self-Service"
- 5. Choose the respective request option
- 6. Select "Yes, I want this document to be created"
- 7. Click "Next" on the top left corner twice as guided by the prompter
- 8. After approximately **5-10 minutes** your requested document will be generated and accessible under "My documents" (this tab can be found by scrolling down on your Dashboard)
