## Taking public transport?

Heading from Bremen Airport, take tram line 6 towards Bremen Hbf. Check tram timetable [here](#)

From Bremen Hbf, regional trains run every 15-30 minutes to Schönebeck Station and [beyond](#)

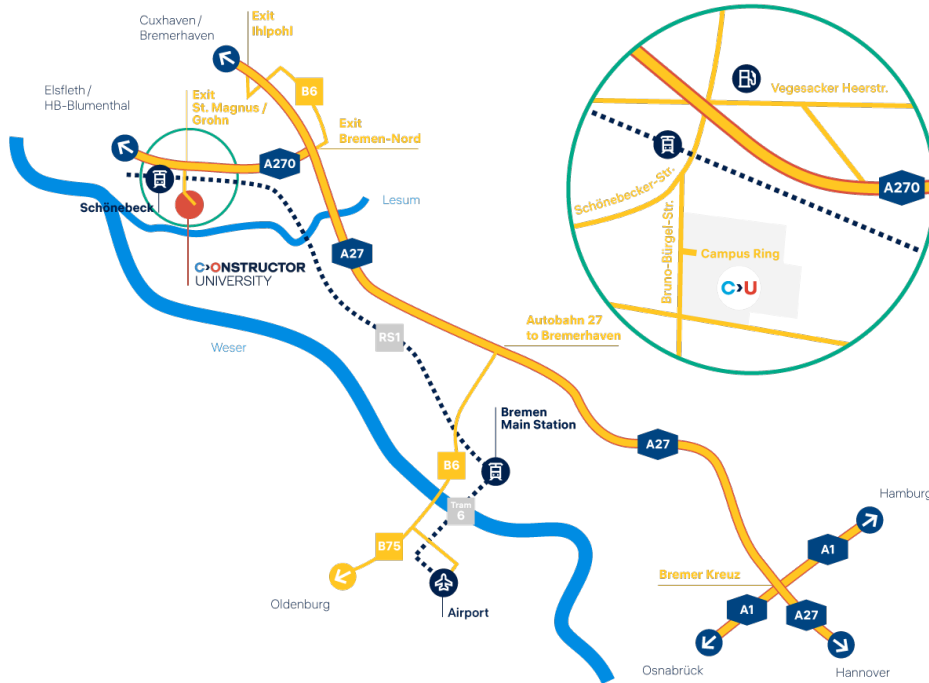
- Take the RS1 train heading towards Bremen-Vegesack
- Get off at Schönebeck Station (6th stop)
- From Schönebeck Station it is a 5-minute walk to the Campus down Schönebecker Straße and Bruno-Bürgel-Straße

# How to reach Constructor University



## Traveling by car?

Traveling from the South:

- Take Autobahn 27 in the direction of Bremerhaven.
- Exit at Bremen-Nord and stay in the left lane.
- Merge onto Autobahn 270, direction Elsfleth / HB-Blumenthal.

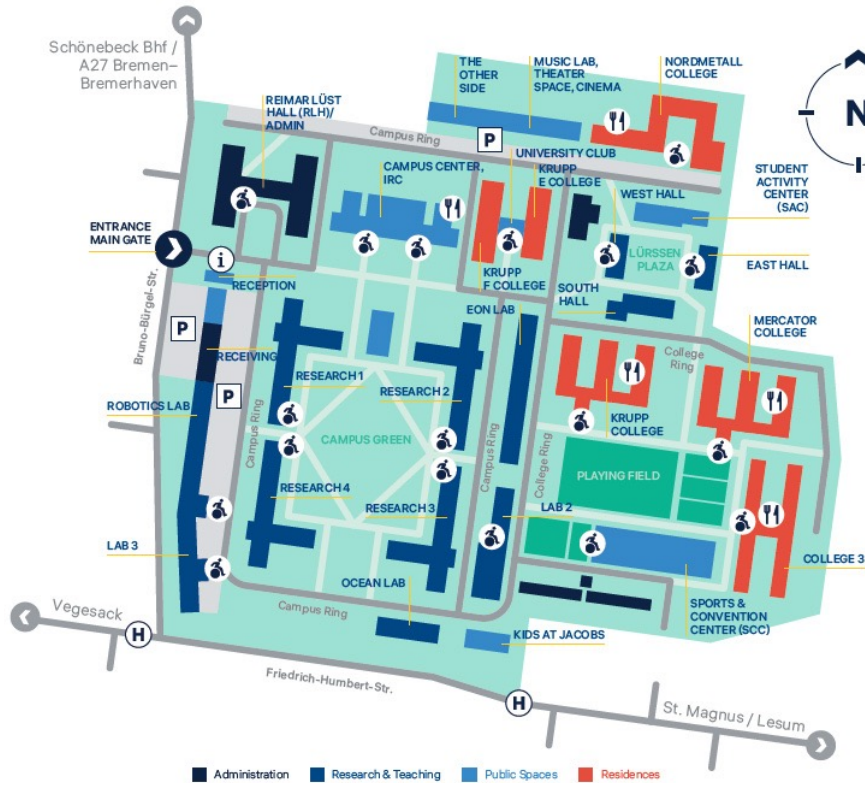
Traveling from the North:

- Take Autobahn 27 in the direction of Bremen.
- Exit at Ihlpohl, and at the end of the exit ramp, turn left.
- Pass under the bridge, then turn right onto B6.
- Turn left onto Autobahn 270, direction Elsfleth / HB-Blumenthal.

Then continue:

- Exit Autobahn 270 at Bremen-St. Magnus / Grohn / Constructor University.
- At the end of the exit ramp, turn left toward U5 / Grohn / Constructor University.
- At the next traffic light, turn left onto Schönebecker Straße, heading toward Grohn.
- After crossing the bridge, keep left and turn into Bruno-Bürgel-Straße.
- After approximately 300 meters, you will arrive at the entrance (Main Gate) of the Campus, which will be on your left-hand side.

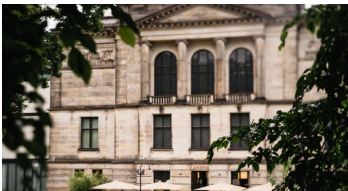


## Riva
